Thank you, and the entire Caring Music Group, for your performance of **For the Love of It** on May 10. This was the third time we have worked with you on a fundraiser and it is always a joy to work with you and your crew. We raised \$5400 with that event.

In 2015 we collaborated on a live cabaret and raffle event **Crazy 'bout You** that netted \$7500 and the 2021 virtual cabaret, **Moonshadow Cares**, brought in \$7300. Hidden though is a recurring donation of \$150 per month that started after that 2021 event – that adds an additional \$5400 so far. The grand total of money you raised for us, including all three events and that recurring donation is now at \$25,600! And that total will keep growing at \$1800 per year.
